2 Day Preschool Tuesday and Thursday 8:30 am - 11:30 am

Our 2-day program is perfect for our youngest students, ages 3 and 4. This program introduces children to a school setting with an emphasis on developing social and emotional skills. Students will explore all aspects of our curriculum, building a foundation for a love of learning and discovering the wonderful world God created for them.

3 Day Preschool Monday/Wednesday/Friday 8:30 am - 11:30 am

The 3-day program is designed for students ages 3, 4, and 5. Students will delve deeper into our curriculum, practicing skills and building independence while nurturing a love of learning. Families can expect "home connections" about once a month.

5 Day Pre-Kindergarten Monday - Friday 8:30 am - 11:30 am

Our 5-day Pre-Kindergarten program is specifically designed to prepare your 4 or 5-year-old for kindergarten. Your family will receive a skills sheet to help prepare your child over the summer before their Pre-K year. Students will immerse themselves in our preschool curriculum and our supplemental "Pre-K Get Set for School" curriculum. There's a strong emphasis on independence and self-care, and weekly "homework" will help students practice routines for kindergarten success. Pre-K students are assessed for early literacy indicators, and results are shared at mid-year conferences and in end-of-year progress reports.



Raising a Reader

All students participate in Raising a Reader, an award-winning literacy enrichment program. For 12 weeks, students bring home books and learn new reading techniques weekly. This program aims to foster family connection and a lifelong love of reading.
